I am writing to nominate Mr. Ken Allred for the position of President of the International Federation of Surveyors (FIG). Mr. Allred has been active in FIG since attending his first Congress in Stockholm in 1977. He has served as the Canadian delegate on Commission 1 - Professional Practice since 1981. In Melbourne (1994), he was elected Chair of Commission 1 for the term 1994 -1998. Ken served on the Organizing Committee for the FIG Symposium on the Decision Maker and LIS in Edmonton in 1984.
