Member association registration for voting

Eligible to vote are *member associations* (MA) in good standing. This official representative will receive the emails with the link to voting and will cast the vote on behalf of the association. This year there will be the election for Commission Chairs elect, the destination and host for FIG Working Week 2029, and finally a proposal from Council to a change in the FIG Internal Rules on the election on Commission Chairs Elects. There will be up to two rounds of voting.

We wish to remind Member Associations that only those who have paid all their arrears will be allowed to vote at the General Assembly. A list of Member Associations with arrears will be published on the agenda web site prior to the General Assembly.
