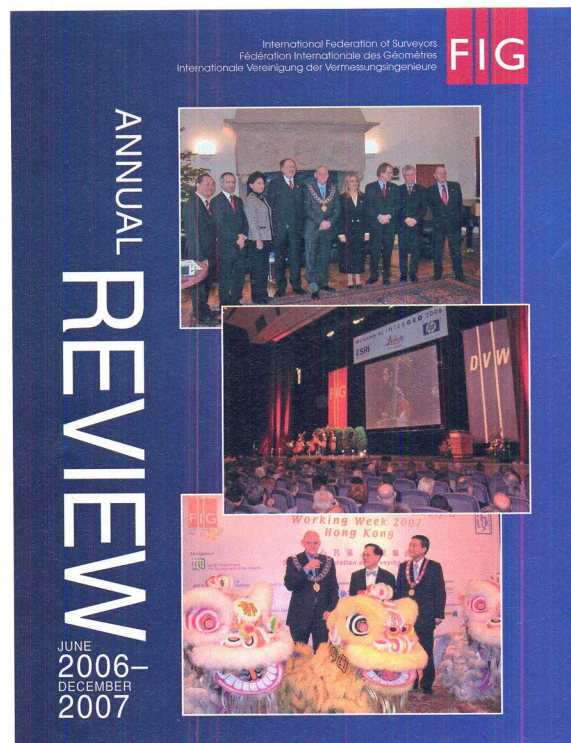
## FIG Annual Review

Apart from reports on the FIG events in Munich, the Working Week in Hong Kong and the Regional Conference in Costa Rica in 2007, the review highlights the key points of the Working Plan 2007-2010, and activities including those of FIG Commissions and members' visits. The increasing co-operation as an NGO with the United Nations and the World Bank is also reported upon, as well as the work of permanent FIG institutions such as the OICRE, with its library on cadastre and land management.
