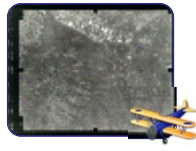

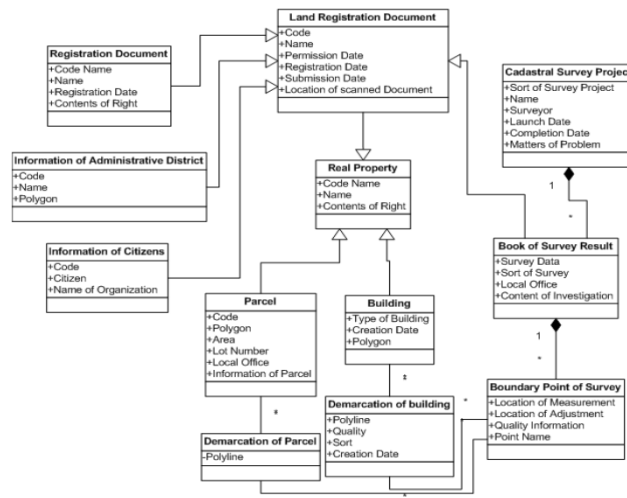

- Work process



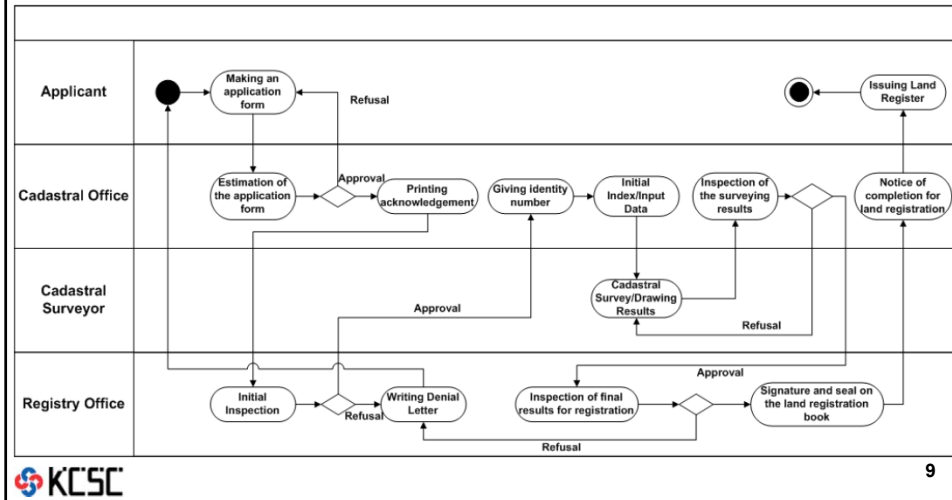

- The Key Land Registration Process Model

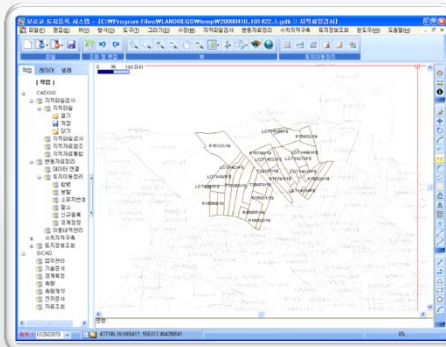


4. Development of Cadastral Management System

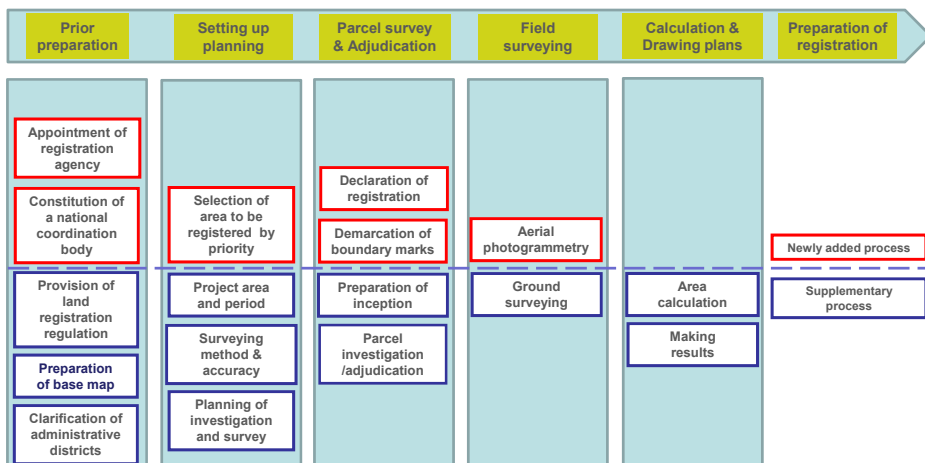
