



Brief on Land Rights in Uganda

- In Uganda, land belongs to the citizens. The Republic of Uganda Constitution of 1995 provides for ownership of land under four types of tenure, namely;
 - Customary
 - Mailo
 - Freehold
 - Leasehold
- As a result, about 80% of land is held under customary land tenure and governed by customary laws in the different regions (North, South, Western, and Eastern Uganda) of the Country.
 - In some Areas across the Country, land is communally owned and mostly based on hereditary principles typical customary.






